Why Internet Violence?

- Instant delivery of message!
- Violent websites are difficult and time-consuming to track down and close
- Can reach vulnerable people in their homes or on their mobile phones without anyone else being aware
- A picture tells a thousand words - Videos can be much more powerful than books in making people turn to violence!
